- . Actively recruit members of the community as volunteers.
- . Rental of community hall and grounds for private functions.
- . Promote events based on community interest (Jamborees, Hoe Down, Mud bogs, Fall Festival, and celebrations of holidays (Christmas, Family Day).
- . Generate funds through grants and fundraising ideas.
- . Maintain good standing with Alberta Museum Association, Heritage Boiler Association (Alberta), Service Alberta for Society Annual Return, WCB.

BUDGET PRIORITIES FOR 2023/2024:

Ensure funds are available to pay for committed expenses such as utility and other maintenance costs.

Continue to make efforts to repair the steam boiler as per the regulations of ABSA.

Responsible to manage funds to ensure outside buildings are maintained as necessary and museum artifacts are secured/protected within our control.

Responsible to manage funds to enable the hosting of popular events for public enjoyment (Jamborees, Hoe-Down, Mud Bog, Fall Festival, Christmas and Family Day celebrations).

Continue to lobby Big Lakes County for installation of town water.

Manage funds for future needs such as buildings for storage of equipment, replacement of other assets.
